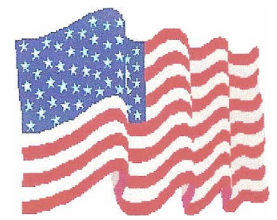

Lady Bugs

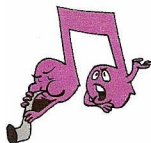
